### Publications/Presentations (to date)

1. 217 publications mostly on Alberta's medical history and Calgary Rotarian Jim Davidson.
2. 114 presentations mostly on historical topics related to Alberta.
3. 12 chapters in books related to historical topics on Alberta/Medicine/Davidson
4. 13 books – 12 self published of which 7 are sole authored, 6 jointly authored. Five more are in process.

### James Wheeler Davidson

1. 2000 – discovered that a Calgarian, James Wheeler Davidson had chartered 32 Rotary clubs around the world from 1921 to 1931 connecting it from Prague to Shanghai. He led the chartering of the Rotary club of Red Deer in 1923.
2. 2002 – found that a Mt Davidson (in Alberta) was named after him but the name was never placed on the Canadian map. Had the error corrected.
3. 2003 – led 24 Rotarians/friends to the top of its 9577ft. peak on a first ascent of Mt Davidson with its new name.
4. 2006 – wrote a source book celebrating the life of James and Lillian Davidson in Rotary.
5. 2022, 2023 – have been an honorary member of the Rotary club of Calgary since 2010. Gave the first and introduced the second luncheon presentations on Davidson's life to the Rotary Club of Calgary.
6. Organized a one-day conference on Davidson at the UofC on June 26, 2025, a day after the RI Convention. 0/15,000 registrants attended it. The presentations were exceptional. If proceedings written, they can be [resented at Taipei in June 2026.

### Miscellaneous

1. Discovered that the concept of government participation in health insurance (now Medicare) in Canada originated in Alberta, not Saskatchewan. (See Making Medicare (2012), and Radical Medicine – an Alberta Perspective, Alberta History 2021)
2. 1963 – Organized the Golden Bowl football game between the UofA and Queens which Alberta won 25-7. That initiated what is now the Vanier Cup.

3. 1964-present - have made 53 successful nominations of Albertans for major awards, including two for Peter Lougheed. Have successfully nominated 5 physicians (and Mr. Lougheed) for induction into the Canadian Medical Hall of Fame.
4. 1994-present - have been the Rotary Club of Red Deer historian for 30 years.
5. 1998, 2006 initiated the creation of two murals on the Black Bonspiel of Willie McCrimmon (4'x54' each), that hang in the Red Deer Curling Club, given in memory of my parents Sadie and Jim Lampard. It was approved by WO Mitchell.
6. 2003 – received the Spaulding Regional Medical Historical award for contributions to medical history in Canada, by the AMS or Hannah Foundation.
7. 2007, 2012 – was appointed an adjunct professor of medical history at the UofA and UofC respectively
8. 2013 - received the UofA Centennial Award for contributions to the University of Alberta
9. 2025 – Videoed the Davidson conference on June 26, 2025, at the UofC
10. 2025 – Reconstituted and reburied the RCRD capsule alongside the Polio Statue at the Rec Center

### Donations

1. Alberta Medical Foundation - \$32,000. Proceeds from the sale of Alberta's Medical History plus another \$1000 in 1997. Gave the AMA my 33 year history of the UofC "ourfutureourpast" website and programs.
2. AMA – created five large photographic collages to hang in the rooms at AMA House in Edmonton which are named after Drs Brett, MacKay, Archer, Mewburn, Jackson. Donated in 2000, 2025. Also mounted the 1937 Gavel.
3. University of Lethbridge – donated over 7000 books and journals to the University of Lethbridge in honor of my aunt Dr. Dorothy Lampard, an original UofLeth. Senator. It was part of their 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebrations in 2017. It created their rare book library. Value \$229,000.
4. Points West Long Term Care facility – donated a complete collection of Canadian Geographic and a complete collection of American National Geographic magazines from 1917 onward. (1600 volumes.)
5. Glacier/Waterton postcards - donated a collection of 171 postcards for scanning and adding to the UofLeth. website.
6. Byron Harmon postcards - donated a collection of 268 postcards for scanning and adding to the UofLeth. website.
7. University of Calgary – donated 13 – 3" binders on James Wheeler Davidson, 90 years of the magazine The Rotarian, and 63 years of the Rotary annual Proceedings, at the same time as the Abramson family (grandson) family donated their Davidson archives to the university in 2012. Updated the Rotarian and Canadian Rotarian donations (2024).
8. Lindsay Thurber Comprehensive High School. Have donated files on the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the school and the Pathways to Education book on (8) early schools in Red Deer. Donated files on the naming of the Hunting Hills High School (vs Peter Fidler).
