Visit a searchable Alberta online medical history collection being developed by the Alberta Medical Foundation (AMF), in partnership with the University of Calgary (U of C) Press and Health Sciences Library.

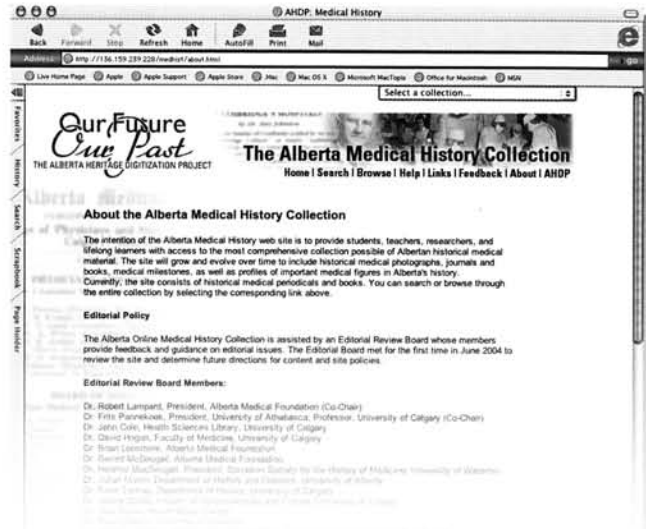

*Our Future, Our Past: Alberta Heritage Digitization Project* (www.ourfutureourpast.ca) hosts the medical history link. The AMF has long sought to make Alberta's medical history resources readily available to students and teachers on the Internet. The ongoing project is university based.

Medical history resources that can be quickly accessed include: more than 35 medical history books, approximately 14 historic Western Canadian medical journals, Department of Public Health and Province of Alberta annual reports (1921-55).

Content is vetted by an academic editorial board. Search medical history resources by book and/or periodical title, chapter and/or article title, book and/or article author, subject and/or full text (Boolean-style searching, including AND and OR operators). Browse the collection alphabetically by title, author or subject. Choose page viewing size.

In addition to medical history, some of it previously difficult to find, access from the site previously scanned Alberta art, aerial photographs, early Alberta newspapers, folklore, retrospective legal material, local histories and more.
